## DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN TBILISI

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## DAY 2: FULL DAY TBILISI CITY TOUR (PRIVATE) GEORGIA 5N/6D

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- Explore the Old Baths and soak in the city's history.
- Wander through Meidani Square, a vibrant part of the old town.
- Visit Shardeni Street, known for its cafes, art galleries, and boutique shops.
- Discover the Gabriadze Clock Tower, a unique and historical landmark.
- Visit Anchiskhati Church and Sioni Church, two of Tbilisi's oldest churches.
- Stroll across the Peace Bridge, a striking glass bridge that lights up at night.
- Take the cable car to Narikala Fortress and enjoy panoramic views of the city.
- Visit the Holy Trinity Sameba Cathedral, one of the largest and most magnificent cathedrals in the world

## DAY 3: JINVALI RESERVOIR, ANANURI CASTLE & KAZBEGI (PRIVATE) GEORGIA 5N/6D

Visit Jinvali Reservoir, a stunning turquoise lake surrounded by mountains.. Explore the Ananuri Castle, a 16th-century castle overlooking the river and mountains.. See the Black and White Aragvi, two distinct rivers that meet at the confluence near Ananuri.

- Arrive in Kazbegi and visit the Gergeti Trinity Church, located at 2,170 meters on a hilltop with breathtaking views of Mount Kazbegi

## DAY 4: KAKHETI WINE REGION (PRIVATE) GEORGIA 5N/6D

Visit the KTW Wine Factory, where you'll get a chance to taste some of the best wines in Georgia.. Explore Bodbe Monastery, an important pilgrimage site and the final resting place of St. Nino.. Visit the charming hilltop town of Signagi, often called the "City of Love" for its romantic atmosphere and picturesque views

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## DAY 5: MTSKHETA, GORI, AND UPLISTSIKHE (PRIVATE)

Visit Mtskheta, one of Georgia's oldest cities and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its historical churches, such as Jvari Monastery and Svetitskhoveli Cathedral.. Head to Gori, the birthplace of Joseph Stalin, and visit the Gori Museum to learn more about his legacy.. Explore the ancient rock-hewn city of Uplistsikhe, an archaeological site that dates back to the early Iron Age. Marvel at the cave dwellings and the ancient theater

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## DAY 6: DEPARTURE FROM TBILISI
